Well Lookups & Reports, KERMIT (manages pipelines and facilities throughout their regulatory lifecycle), ESubmission (the online portal for permit holders to submit well data, reports and operational notices), Application Management System (AMS) (generate and submit applications for wells, pipelines, and facilities), AMS Payment (site for online payment of all applications), GeoSpatial Services (provides access to over 35 datasets which you can download in shapefile format, ePass (provides the ability to submit the spatial components of surface rights applications (SRA) over the Internet).

Through IRIS, the oil and gas industry receives invoices & notifications, submits all regulatory requirements for wells and facilities, submits applications for groupings, extensions, land sale posting and bids, non-prod reviews, offset waivers, new units, unit amendments, mineral disposition transfers,

surrenders, and reinstatements, view mineral lease continuance and obligation reports, and search and view information related to wells, facilities, units, and crown mineral dispositions.
